WATER TREATMENT MANAGER

This position will manage the operations of all water treatment facilities, including two conventional and two direct filtration surface water facilities and seven ground water facilities in south central Connecticut. Key responsibilities include: oversight of water treatment processes to comply with all Safe Drinking Water Act and other related public water supply standards and to comply with relevant Clean Water Act standards, development and/or approval of operational, maintenance, and safety procedures for the facilities, department personnel, efficient and cost effective operation of water treatment facilities, preparation of budgets, participation in the planning process for treatment and distribution water quality needs, and, as needed, implement and monitor capital improvement projects related to treatment facilities.

The qualified applicant will possess: training and/or knowledge in water treatment processes, standard principles of biology, chemistry, mathematics and hydraulics, laboratory techniques, and applicable safety practices; minimum of five (5) years experience managing Class IV Public Water System Treatment Facilities; ability to problem solve in a team setting; ability to maintain productive working relationships; and ability to communicate effectively. A Bachelor's Degree in a relevant engineering or science field is required.
